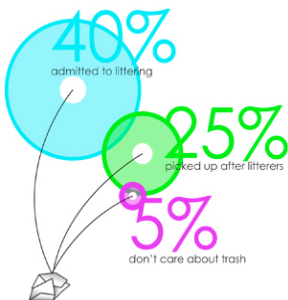
Make yourself heard!

## What is NUF SAID?

It's the only project of its kind in the whole country! NUF SAID youth producers are journalists and media artists who are currently polling their peers about the issues they care about most: school, jobs, violence, the environment, etc. Using the data from these polls, youth producers will create stories that reflect the REAL experiences of Chicago youth today!

## Who are the NUF SAID producers?

NUF SAID youth producers come from all neighborhoods around Chicago who are involved in media arts programs either in school or after school. Most, but not all youth producers are high school students with a passion for telling stories and getting their voice heard!



## What will the final project look like?

Picture a website with all kinds of media on it: videos, photos, audio recordings, print articles, and much more: that's NUF-SAID.org. Plus, the website will also feature all of the data that the youth producers collect by polling hundreds of their peers.

## How do you get involved?
